Impact of the Covid pandemic on our project

Due to the covid-19 pandemic that broke out all over the world, our project also inevitably suffered delays and the partnership decided to ask the Erasmus Plus INDIRE National Agency in Italy for an extension period of six months (to avoid possible increases in infections also in the staff of the various partner organizations) which the Agency itself promptly approved.

Now the project, which was initially supposed to end on 31.12.2020, is expected to end on 30.06.2021

However, the project went ahead and the partners, although they could not meet in person, after the first period of discouragement due to the development situation of the pandemic in the world, have slowly resumed work on the project activities and have in any case been able to meet virtually to define the work to be developed.

For this purpose, some skype meetings were organized in which the work to be developed and the new deadlines for delivering the same were defined.



Fourth project meeting moved to Berlin

The fourth project meeting was held on 15-16 September 2020 in Berlin, instead of Budapest due to the development of the pandemic in Hungary.

Unfortunately, precisely due to the increase in infections in their country, the staff of the Hungarian partner IKTE was unable to attend the meeting in Berlin, as they would have been forced to 14 days of quarantine.

In any case, the Hungarian friends connected via skype and followed the activities on a virtual basis, actively participating in all the decisions taken during the meeting in Germany.

The Berlin meeting was organized by the German partner CRN in a coworking center in the city center where the distancing and control of the gatherings of people could be ensured.

Obviously, the participants have always respected all the safety standards established at European level in order to reduce the risk of contagion and some of them even underwent the swab before leaving for Germany in order to reassure the other fellow partners with whom they would soon be met in Berlin.

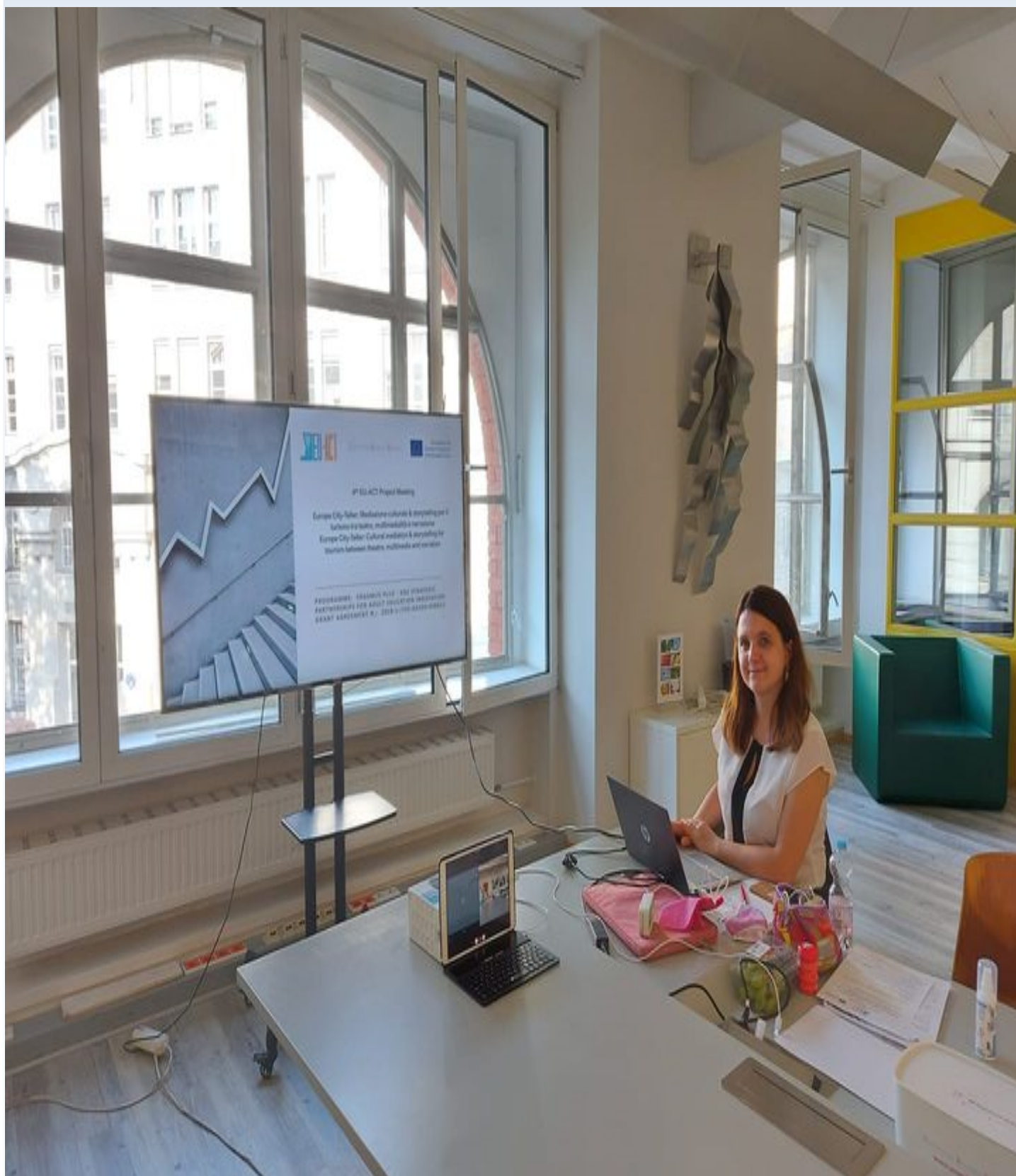
